Adventureland Resort Begins Upgrade of Underground Roller Coaster for the Park's 50th Birthday Celebration

The train has been sent to Philadelphia Toboggan Coasters in Hatfield, Pennsylvania where it is receiving a full rebuild.

"This enhancement of *Underground* represents a major milestone for Adventureland, as we honor our past while embracing the future," said Mike Lusky, Adventureland General Manager. "We can't wait for our guests to embark on this new adventure as we celebrate the park's 50th birthday in 2024."
